What Is Home Health?



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What Is Home Health?

Home Health is a combination of medical services delivered in your home at the request of your physician when you have experienced a change in your medical condition. The job of the Home Health Professional is to teach the patient and/or caregiver how to care for the current medical problem.



What Services Are Available?

We proudly offer skilled services provided by registered nurses, physical therapists, occupational therapists, speech therapists, medical social workers and Home Health aides.

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How Would I Arrange For Home Health Services?

Anyone is eligible for a free Home Health evaluation to determine their need for services. If appropriate, your physician would need to request Home Health Services on your behalf.

What Would Make Me Eligible For Home Health Services?



In order to receive Home Health Care you must be homebound. This means you must experience a taxing effort to leave the home. Absences from the home should be for short periods and infrequent.

The care you require must be skilled In nature. This means the care you receive can be delivered only by a skilled medical professional.

The care you require must be intermittent. This means the care you receive must be more than one visit and a reasonable level of rehabilitation can be expected with treatment.

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What Types of Conditions Would Indicate A Need For Home Health Care?

Patients with one or more of the following conditions may be eligible for Home Health services:

- ☞ New surgical procedure.
- ☞ New or change in your medical diagnosis.
- ☞ Difficulty walking, transferring, or performing regular daily activities.
- ☞ New or changed medication
- ☞ Problems with talking or swallowing.
- ☞ New medical equipment such as oxygen, a walker, blood sugar meter, etc
- ☞ New or changed caregiver
